

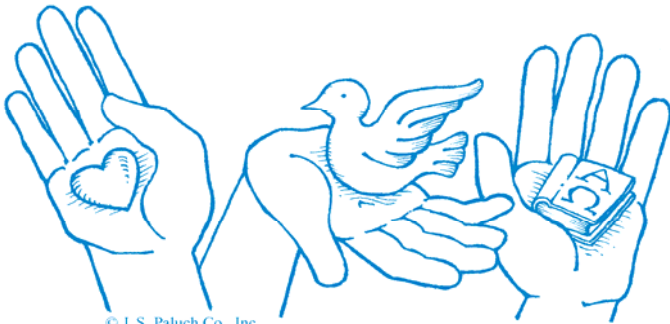
Welcome to Saint Gall Catholic Community

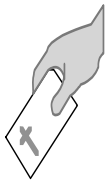
