

Confirmation Requirements for Your Saint Report

In the sacrament of Confirmation, we choose a name to be confirmed under. It should be the name of a saint that models for you what it truly means to be holy and Christ like. When you choose this saint, you need to reflect on these points;

- ❖ Why is this person a good role model for me?
- ❖ How did he or she exemplify a holy life?
- ❖ What did this person do during their life that made them saintly?
- ❖ What personal connections can you make about this saint?
- ❖ What gifts of the Holy Spirit were most prevalent in this saint's life?
- ❖ How will this saint help you on your life long walk with God?

After reflecting on the life of this saint you are required to complete a report. This report should include the saint's name, their birth and death date, and three to five specific facts about their life; explain why you have chosen this person, and how this saint will help you stay focused on God and the teachings of our Catholic Church.

Report options:

- Write a traditional 1-page paper (single spaced) IN YOUR OWN WORDS
- Create a 5-8 slide power point presentation (may use for your oral presentation)

All reports require a colorful handout flyer featuring your saint's "wow" facts.
